MEADOWGLEN PRIMARY SCHOOL



Meadowglen Primary School was opened in 1990 and is situated in the Epping area, north of Melbourne. It is surrounded by new housing in the Meadowglen Estate, with a steadily growing school population.

Currently the school has 750 pupils but an increase is expected over the next few years because of one new housing estate to the north east and a slightly smaller one to the south east. These estates have an aggregate of more than 300 house blocks which already have completed dwellings.

The school buildings are situated in attractively landscaped school grounds with lawn areas, basketball courts, football, soccer and cricket playing areas, a gymnasium, canteen, art room, performing arts room, a centrally located library, and outdoor playground equipment.



Programs

The school provides developmental programs in each of the eight learning areas, including an Italian LOTE program which operates from Year 1 to Year 6. There is an emphasis on **English, Maths and Student Wellbeing**. As a result of whole school planning, we are adopting throughout the school an integrated curriculum approach which focuses on children and the processes of thinking and learning.



Technology

The school uses IBM compatible computers which are stationed in all classrooms. Networking of all classrooms has been completed and provides access to the Internet through VICONE. The school library has a computerized borrowing system, has access to CD ROM computers for research and is also connected to the Internet.

Student Wellbeing

The School provides outstanding student welfare support through the provision of a full time Student Wellbeing teacher / co-ordinator and access to a wide range of professional support staff.

Parent participation is actively encouraged in both formal and informal activities and the success is reflected in strong representation in the classroom, camps, sporting events, special activities, fundraising, School Council and Parents Club Association.

An approved school uniform is compulsory and is well supported by the students and their parents. As part of the uniform policy, the school supports the Sunsmart program by advocating compulsory wearing of hats during outdoor activities in Terms 1 and 4.

The school also provides for childcare through its Out of School Hours Care Program which operates both before and after school.
